## TICKETS GO ON SALE THIS SATURDAY, OCTOBER 7, 2006 FOR THE HISTORIC PRODUCTION OF *URINETOWN- THE COMEDY MUSICAL*, AT THE DENVER WASTEWATER MANAGEMENT BUILDING

Tickets to the long-awaited production of *Urinetown- The Comedy Musical* go on sale this Saturday, October 7, 2006 at 10:00am. *Urinetown- The Comedy Musical* is being produced for the first time ever in a building other than a theatre. It will be staged at the City & County of Denver's Public Works Wastewater Management building at 2000 West 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue., in Denver, Colorado. Tickets are available online only by visiting www.UrinetownDenver.org.

The show will run Nov. 3 through Dec. 3, 2006, with one show Fridays & Saturdays at 8pm and two shows Sundays at 1pm and 5pm. Tickets are \$30 (which includes a \$23 ticket plus all city seat tax, processing fee, and facility service/power contributions).

The show is the first locally produced version in Denver and features 15 actor/singer/dancers and a live, 5-piece orchestra. SCORE Marketing will produce it, Dan Wiley will direct it with Musical/Vocal direction by Amanda Farnsworth and Choreography by Juliana Black. Urinetown, by Mark Hollmann and Greg Kotis, is a love story set in a futuristic, drought-ridden society where citizens have to pay for the privilege of using the restroom. It is drop-dead funny and pokes fun at itself as a musical, private industry, and society as a whole. It was the 2002 winner of an unheard-of three Tony Awards including Best Direction, Best Music and Best Book/Lyrics. It is being produced in special arrangement with Music Theatre International and Actors Equity Association.
